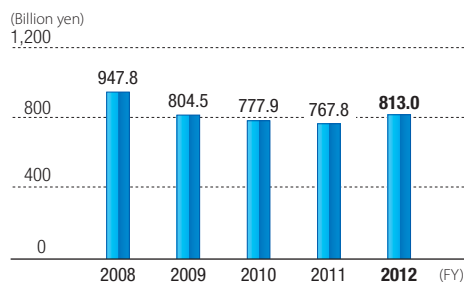

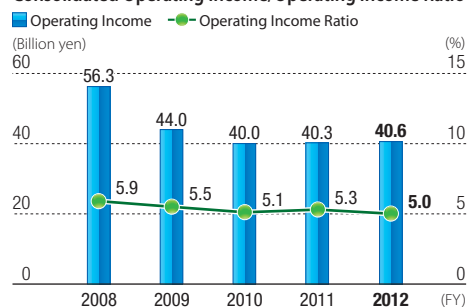

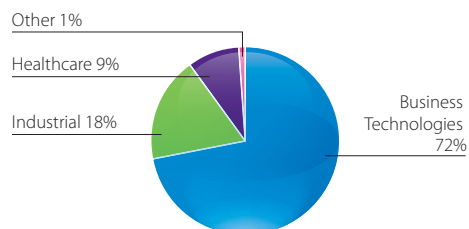
Consolidated Net Sales



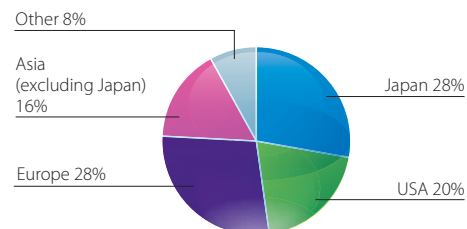
Consolidated Operating Income/Operating Income Ratio
