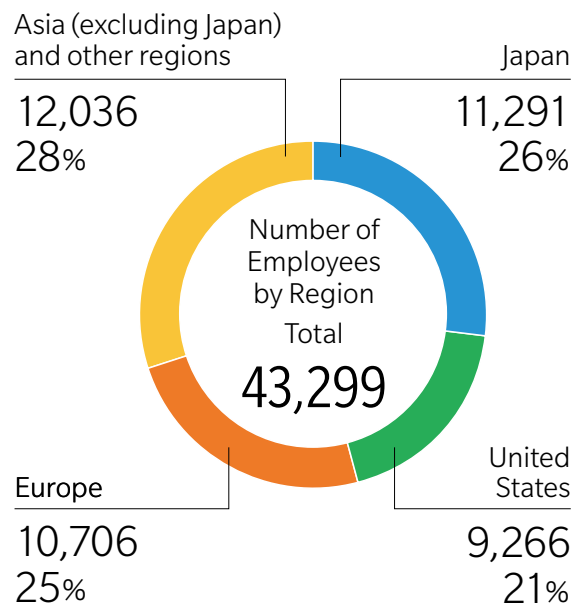


Consolidated Operating Income / Operating Income Ratio
